Attendance Hints & Tips

Bring:

Comfortable walking shoes – show grounds are huge!

Sunscreen; large exhibit hangars and stores provide relief, but you will be outside a LOT!

Weather can be unpredictable: prepare for sunny & hot, cool & overcast, potentially rain

Backpack for swag ok; camp chair or blanket ok if planning to watch planes, airshows, fireworks

Food available on grounds, ok to bring your own food

Personally owned vehicles (bikes, scooters, golf carts, one-wheels, etc) not permitted inside show grounds

Ok in Camp Scholler; bike racks available at show entrance

If attending full week, consider a museum day for respite

Grounds are huge - plan ahead!

Download and update app/content: schedules, maps, exhibitor lookup, etc

ATC Tower is visible from most places, makes excellent landmark

Free trams & shuttles available throughout the grounds; frequently crowded

Handicap services available: parking near main gate, rental scooters, golf cart rides

Golf cart ride also available for pilots that flew in and need to haul gear to Scholler, FBO, etc

Show admission “ticket” is a wristband; available as daily or weekly; Age 18 and younger free, but still need wristband

Grounds access Sunday before show start requires Monday or weekly wristband

The latest on “Scholler-bike-gate”

The following are banned:

- E-Motorcycles
- E-scooters
- Segways
- E-unicycles
- E-hoverboards
- E-skateboards

Bicycles, E-bicycles, mopeds, dirt bikes, ATVs, and UTVs are still allowed with the following restrictions:

- All of the above must be registered at the time of registration in the campground. You must sign a waiver and put a sticker on your vehicle/bike
- Operation at night requires front and rear facing lights
- 10 mph speed limit
- Must be 16 years old to operate a motorized vehicle

Security and Law Enforcement will be in the campground will issue warnings for violations. Any repeated "violations" may result in 2027 camping privileges revoked.
